I would like to also mention that Coles and Woolworths have initiated an Online Priority Service for older residents and pensioners for home delivery. You can register online if you have a computer or let me know and I will try and help you access this service. I've attached information on both these offers.





A very important message I need to pass on to everyone also is regarding flu injections. It seems a lot of you have been very vigilant in obtaining your vaccinations early. The Government has advised that everyone entering an aged care facility after 1st May will need to have a current flu vaccination with NO exemptions other than documented medical advice based on a pre-existing condition only. This will include all our staff, visitors and even contractors and evidence of immunisation will be required so could you please ask your doctor to provide you with evidence you have had the flu needle.

Easter is fast approaching and due to the Covid-19 restrictions the main building will be locked and only open for Care Residents visiting hours from 10am - 2pm Friday, Saturday and Monday, closed on Sunday.
